

10. **LB Bromley Resident's Federation** – Chris and Carol Mulinder attended a Bromley Federation meeting which included a presentation from Biggin Hill Airport saying they would concentrate on small (22 seater) jets and not seek any planning permission again. They reported that Cherry Tree Golf Club had applied for permission to remodel some greens that involved a large number of lorry movements in Jail Lane over 15 months. 140 per day. KVRA were concerned that it would increase the number of lorries travelling through the village. Alexa is on the Planning Committee.
