

b) To suggest to BRAAD that a public meeting is arranged to inform residents who live close to the airport and on the flight path exactly what the implications of the BHAL proposals are. This will also enable a more realistic assessment of the strength of feeling to be judged. Residents' Associations in the following areas could be used to spread the meeting arrangements to residents; Biggin Hill, Blackness Lane, Cudham, Downe, Farnborough, Keston Mark, Keston Park, Keston Village and Leaves Green.

c) KVRA would be prepared to send a representative to BRAAD meetings if that was deemed to be constructive.
